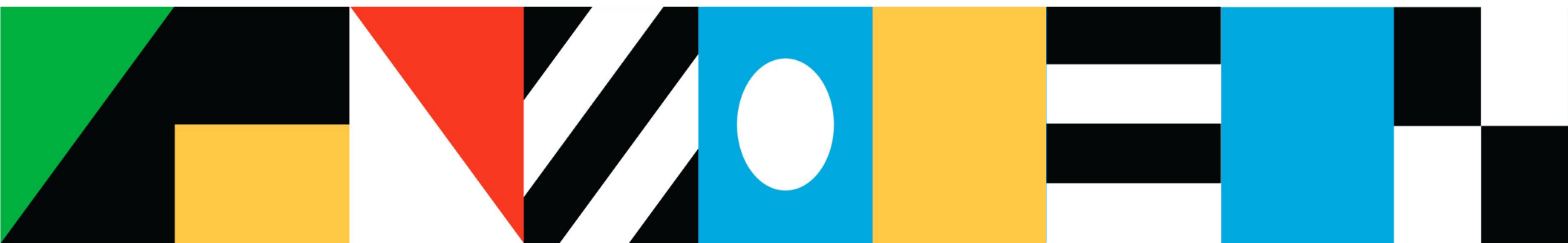

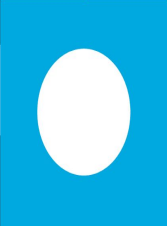

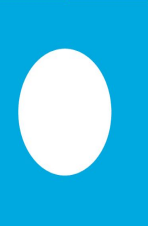


- If you are not a beginner, but you don't know what lesson/unit to start from, take the placement test.

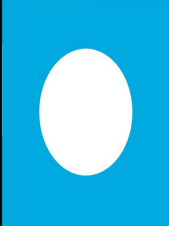

- The speaker that both speech patterns are connected to plays both recordings at the same time so that you can compare the pronunciations.
